Your patient will receive an EOB (Explanation of Benefits) from your insurance company denying to pay, or pay the full amount, of our claim. This will be followed by an invoice from PediaCare Medical for the *same* deductible, co-pay, or co-insurance for the medical equipment that your patient would have paid under In-Network Contracted Provider rates.






PEDIATRIC SLEEP APNEA AND MONITORING

Overview

Pediatric obstructive sleep apnea is a sleep disorder in which your child's breathing is partially or completely blocked repeatedly during sleep. The condition is due to narrowing or blockage of the upper airway during sleep.

There are differences between pediatric obstructive sleep apnea and adult sleep apnea. While adults usually have daytime sleepiness, children are more likely to have behavioral problems. The underlying cause in adults is often obesity, while in children the most common underlying condition is enlargement of the adenoids and tonsils.

Early diagnosis and treatment are important to prevent complications that can affect children's growth, cognitive development and behavior.

Symptoms

During sleep, signs and symptoms of pediatric sleep apnea might include:

- Snoring
- Snorting, coughing or choking
- Pauses in breathing
- Restless sleep Mouth breathing
- Bed wettingSleep terrors

Infants and young children with obstructive sleep apnea don't always snore. They might just have disturbed sleep.

During the day, children with sleep apnea might:

- Perform poorly in school
- Have learning problems
- Have difficulty paying attention
- Be hyperactive
- Have behavioral problems
- Have poor weight gain

Causes

Obesity is a common factor underlying obstructive sleep apnea in adults. But in children the most common condition leading to obstructive sleep apnea is enlarged tonsils and adenoids. However, obesity also plays a role in children. Other underlying factors can be craniofacial anomalies and neuromuscular disorders.



Risk factors

Besides obesity, other risk factors for pediatric sleep apnea include having:

• History of low birth

• Family history of

obstructive sleep

- Down syndrome
- Abnormalities in the skull or face
- Cerebral palsy
- Sickle cell disease
- Neuromuscular disease

Complications

Pediatric obstructive sleep apnea can have serious complications, including:

- Failure to growHeart problems
- Death

MANUAL MOBILITY

Take some time to consider your wheelchair options and the convenience of added accessories.













Transport chairs: Lightweight with foldable frames, simple to use and easy to transport. A good option to help with occasional, short-term mobility needs.

Standard chairs: Weigh between 37 and 47 pounds. Non-adjustable frames are available in basic seat sizes and include options for height-adjustable armrests and elevating leg rests. A good option if you need a basic mobility device to travel short distances or for short periods of time.

Lightweight chairs: Usually weigh between 24 and 34 pounds. Available in basic seat sizes with some armrest and leg rest options. Low seat height on some models allows you to propel with your feet . An appropriate option if using the chair for several hours during the day, are mildly active and primarily propelling on flat surfaces.

High-strength lightweight chairs: Weigh between 30 and 34 pounds. Various options available to help maintain good seated posture and propel with ease. Good choice if using a manual chair for most of your mobility, are in the chair most of the day and lead a mild to moderately active lifestyle.

Ultra-lightweight chairs: Aluminum frames weigh between 18 and 28 pounds, while titanium frames can weigh as little as 16 pounds. Built for performance, efficiency and ease of maneuverability over varying terrain. A great choice if you use the chair for all your mobility, lead an active lifestyle and/or need individual tailoring for your complex seating and functional needs.

Heavy duty and bariatric chairs: Weigh between 50 and 60 pounds. Larger seat sizes, reinforced upholstery and reinforced frames accommodate user weights from 250 to 1,000 pounds. Available options vary according to the model, chair type and weight capacity.

Get the Supplies Your Child Needs

Diapers and approved supplies are covered through Medicaid when a qualified physician diagnoses a child with incontinence. A prescription is needed to receive support through Medicaid. The amount and duration of service depend on an individual basis. If your child is over the age of three and suffers from incontinence, PediaCare Medical can help you get the disposable incontinence supplies needed for your child to stay comfortable. We work with Medicaid to provide your growing child with a free monthly supply of diapers to save families the expense of purchasing diapers from the store. Medicaid supplies diapers to children over the age of three when the following applies:

- The child has a medical condition resulting in incontinence
- Medicaid is the primary or secondary payer





We understand the importance of nutrition and our priority is to help patients get and stay healthy. Our Process

Benefit Investigation – We conduct a Benefit Investigation to help you better understand your patient's health plan coverage of available nutrition products and any associated out-of-pocket costs. We can also determine if prior authorization is required by the health plan. To initiate a Benefit Investigation, simply fax us an order form indicating the product required, dosage information, ICD-10 diagnosis, and patient demographics to (888) 367-4530

Prior Authorization Support – We will assist with the prior authorization process to help patients get the appropriate product that you have recommended. When Prior Authorization is required, we will reach out to your office and collect any further required information including payer specific Prior Authorization forms. Additionally, we continually monitor the process by contacting the payer to confirm they received all required information and follow up with the payer to determine the outcome.

Appeal Process Research and Support – PediaCare Medical will review information and contact the payer to understand the cause for denial of our nutrition products and the payer-specific appeal or resubmission process. Our office will thenprovide next steps to you and follow up with the payer to determine the outcome of the claim appeal or resubmission.

Billing and Coding Information and Support – Through the use of manufacturer-recommended published HCPCS codes, we will bill the patient's insurance and share co-insurance information with the patient.

- Any supporting documentation including:
 - The health plan's prior authorization form
 - Relevant patient history and physical findings
 - Chart notes from the healthcare provider
 - Test and lab results
 - Hospital admission/emergency department notes (if applicable)



FAQ's

Q. How does a patient get a breast pump through their insurance?

A. Breast pumps are covered by most insurance plans and we are a preferred breast pump provider with most PPO insurance policies and some Medicaid plans. Simply fill out our order form for your patient to order an insurance covered breast pump for your patients and one of our breast pump specialists will contact your patient immediately.

Q. What is the benefit of getting a breast pump through PediaCare Medical vs. a retailer?

A. Per the Affordable Care Act, most insurance companies are now covering breast pumps at little to no cost to patients. Insurance companies still have different stipulations and guidelines for the pumps: some require prescriptions, prior authorization, etc. Our breast pump specialists will verify your patient's insurance benefits, obtain any necessary paperwork, and file the claim with your patient's insurance plan. All of our breast pumps come with a manufacturer's warranty. We also verify coverage for additional breast pump supplies after the patient's baby is born.

Q. When can I get a breast pump?

A. Patients can qualify for your breast pump through insurance at any time during their pregnancy and up to one year postpartum. However, some insurance policies may dictate when we are actually able to ship their breast pump.

Q. How long will it take to receive my breast pump after I qualify?

A. Once we've received a prescription order form for your patients, a breast pump specialist will contact them to share more about their options and any guidelines from their insurance plan regarding when the breast pump can be shipped. As soon as the breast pump ships, your patient will be notified.

Q. What is a breast pump upgrade?

A. Insurances will cover all the parts that a patient needs in order to express breast milk. A breast pump upgrade includes convenience items that are not fully covered by a patient's insurance plan and would require an additional fee. We offer a wide variety of comfortable and practical upgrades for your patients at very affordable rates.

Q. Can a patient use their HSA/FSA funds to purchase an upgrade breast pump and breast pump accessories?

A. Our website does accept FSA/HSA cards as a form of payment. Each FSA/HSA plan has different guidelines, so we always recommend that a patient checks their plan for any specific questions.

Q. Can patients return their breast pump?

A. PediaCare Medical does not accept returns on breast pumps. We are on standby 24/7 to assist patient's with their equipment, and work to resolve any issues as soon as they arise. For malfunctioning equipment, patient's are encouraged to directly contact the manufacturer of the equipment as they would ultimately be able to repair or replace a pump and/or supplies as necessary.

Q. What if a breast pump is not working properly?

A. All of our breast pumps come with a manufacturer's warranty. If a patient is experiencing issues with their breast pump, they can contact us and we will provide the correct manufacturer contact information.

Q. Do you offer hospital grade breast pump rentals?

A. Yes, either through insurance depending on your patient's policy or for cash rental at very affordable rates. Some plans do not cover hospital grade breast pumps. These pumps provide a stronger strength suction, special wavelength, and programming that allows a mother with certain medical necessities to produce the maximum amount of breast milk possible. This breast pump is ideal while their child is in the NICU or otherwise unable to feed due to a medical condition. Hospital grade pumps can also help establish or increase milk supply.

Q. Does insurance cover additional supplies?

A. Some insurance plans cover additional supplies after a patient's baby is born. Our breast pump specialists will check the patient's insurance coverage to see if they are eligible.

PHOTOTHERAPY

PediaCare Medical offers same-day service and the most advanced biliblanket phototherapy technology to help infants with hyperbilirubinemia, also known as jaundice. Biliblankets have become a popular treatment option for patients because it allows them to treat their child in the comfort of their home.

While using our units parents can still hold, feed and play with their child. Our biliblanket pads are flexible and come with a disposable sleeve that wraps around the baby's mid-section to provide maximum coverage during phototherapy treatment. Blue light comes through the sleeve, which reduces dangerous bilirubin levels.

If your patient has elevated bilirubin levels (typically between of 10-18 mg/dL), simply fax us a biliblanket order form and we will deliver the equipment to your patient's home **the same day**, so that their family may avoid an otherwise

unnecessary trip to the NICU. We are approved by Medicaid and many private insurances to provide Biliblanket equipment at little or no cost to your patients. By providing your patients with easy-access to a biliblanket, we can avoid a hospital admission and still provide the same care.

In all cases, the quick and effective use of a biliblanket can help a baby have a swift recovery. We even allow our referral offices store a biliblanket on-site in order to quickly address the needs of their patient base.


